


Installation as Settled Pastor

Music Committee Survey: Praise Team at Barre Congregational Church

this new experience for Barre Congregational Church:

To best meet the needs of our church the Music Committee respectfully requests your vital input:

Purpose: The primary purpose and focus of all music at our church service is to focus on worshiping and glorifying our Triune God.

What is "Praise Team"? A Praise team, aka Worship team, refers to a genre of musical worship designed to encourage participation in community worship. Praise music is intended to be inspiring, uplifting, and can be a powerful tool for evangelism, attracting new members. Many of the songs are contemporary, but Praise team music is not constrained to the modern, and often includes traditional hymns which are often played on the organ.

How is it Done? Much like our choir, Praise Team vocalists and instrumentalists musically lead and encourage the congregation throughout the service. Because this genre encourages congregant participation, unlike the choir, there generally is not a 'special' anthem where congregants sit, watch, and listen. All song lyrics are projected so those church members who wish to look up while praising, may do so if they choose. At Barre, we intend to provide lyric sheets and notation for those that wish to read the music as they may do from the hymnals.

Because praise music usually includes electronic instruments, like guitar and bass, vocalists who lead utilize microphones to balance the sound with the instruments. The use of those tools, however, is not meant to signal a band performance. The primary focus is on praising together to glorify God.
